Change on February 20, 2024 Treasurer's Report – the Difference from +2,533.62 to +1,685.62. A motion made by Diane Fahnestock to accept the previous minutes with noted changes. Judy Bublitz made a motion to accept. Motion was seconded by Diane Fahnestock. Motion carried. **Old Business:**

a. Church Credit Card – Don Looper explained we can keep the same credit card (Chase) just need to change custodian ship from Patti McCabe to Don Looper.

b. Faith Garden Board – Kristen Hummel has volunteered along with Rick Pietrzak. Still need 1 more for board. Council recommended the existing board start working with the 2 new board members.

c. Sidewalk and South Steps of Fellowship Hall – need 3 concrete quotes.

d. Carpet – Romeo Floors - \$13,411.16 plus \$1,176.00 to rip out existing carpet; The Carpet Guys \$16,467.00 including rip out existing carpet; The Carpet Store Lapeer - \$15,625.68 does not include rip out existing carpeting. For vinyl flooring \$29,895.56

e. Insurance – Jean Bonier will contact insurance company to find out why the church now has a \$10,000 water deductible.

f. QuickBooks – Faith Garden Board has agreed to continue to split the cost. g. Camera – moving camera into secretary's office is being worked on by Ken DeYonker.

h. Audit committee - has met and started working on the audit.

New Business:

a. In order to teach a bible study or class at St. Paul's they must be a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church Imlay City or fill out a facility use form. Sandie Smith made a motion to accept. Motion was seconded by Jean Bonior. Motion carried.

b. Outside yard spring cleaning – a list will be posted for volunteers to help.

c. There is a need to upgrade bathrooms downstairs.

d. Exterior wooden doors need re-stained. Judy Bublitz has volunteered.

e. Church cleaning- need volunteers to fill in while custodian is on vacation. Several church council members have volunteered (March 24-March 31)

f. Organ Repair -2 of the 4 power amps are not working properly, therefore the balance is off. To replace amps will cost \$4,250.00. As of now the organ is usable and balanced as best as it can be.

Checking with Sheryl Laidlaw on her thoughts. Don Looper will contact Sarah to email Organ Company – Dennis Verner to let him know we are not going to repair organ at this time.

g. Lawn Care – Rock Steady Lawn Care will be our new lawn care service. \$60.00 per mowing. Chuck Diamond made a motion to
